### Ultrafabrics Awarded CDP 2025 Climate Change Score of “B”

Ultrafabrics Holdings Co., Ltd. was awarded a score of “B” in the CDP 2025 Climate Change Questionnaire conducted by Carbon Disclosure Project (CDP), an international NPO that operates an environmental information disclosure system.

Ultrafabrics provided responses to the 2025 Climate Change Questionnaire conducted by the environmental NGO CDP, and was awarded a score of “B” for two years in a row. In the CDP evaluation framework, a company that receives a B score is described as a “management” level entity, meaning it is aware of the climate-change risks and opportunities and has taken specific action. In the CDP’s eight-stage scoring (A, A-, B, B-, C, C-, D, D-), B is third from top.

Ultrafabrics’ Group Mission Statement includes an intention to “prioritize sustainability while contributing to society”. The Group is proactively implementing climate change action, including the adoption of hydrogen energy in the newly built Chiyoda Plant (Chiyoda, Ora, Gunma). Ultrafabrics will further enhance efforts to tackle climate change to maintain an ongoing contributing to the realization of a carbon free society.
