Notice Regarding Selection as a Constituent of the “JPX Prime 150 Index”

SBI Holdings, Inc. (Head Office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; Representative Director, Chairman, President & CEO: Yoshitaka Kitao; hereinafter the “Company”) hereby announces that it has been selected as a constituent of the “JPX Prime 150 Index,” which is calculated by JPX Market Innovation & Research, Inc.

The “JPX Prime 150 Index” is a stock price index composed of stocks selected to represent “Japanese companies that are estimated to create value” from among the top-ranked stocks listed on TSE Prime Market by market capitalization based on two measures of value creation: 1) “return on capital” which is based on financial results, and 2) “market valuation” which is based on future information and non-financial information.

In selecting the constituents of the “JPX Prime 150 Index,” from among the top 500 stocks by listed market capitalization among the constituents of the TSE Prime Market Index, 75 companies were selected under the “Equity Spread Criteria,” which indicates the extent to which ROE (return on equity) exceeds the cost of capital, and 75 companies were selected under the “PBR (price-to-book ratio) Criteria,” which indicates whether a stock is undervalued or overvalued relative to net assets. As a result, only companies carefully selected from both perspectives—high profitability and high market valuation—are included as constituents. Among these, the Company was selected under the “Equity Spread Criteria.”

Going forward, we will continue to strive in our business operations toward sustainable enhancement of corporate value, to meet the expectations of our investors.
